TRIAL PERIOD AND TERMINATION OF SERVICE:

The first 14 calendar days from child's start date are a probationary period for the provider, child, and parent. This agreement may be terminated at any time during this period. After the probationary period, this agreement may be terminated by either party by giving two-week's written notice if the child or children are to be permanently withdrawn from daycare. Two-week's pay will be accepted in lieu of the two-week's written notice. The Provider will also give the Family two-week's written notice of intent to cancel this agreement except in cases of family emergency (Provider's) or gross misconduct on the part of the parent or child. Failure to follow the agreement rules in this contract may be cause for immediate termination with no notice. Provider will give the Family a minimum of two-week's written notice of any increase in fees or significant changes to this agreement.

Any and all additions/changes to this contract must be initialed by both the parent and the provider to be valid.
